Message from FR. MICHAEL L. PASTRIKOS, PROTOPRESBYTER

ere we go again another Ecclesiastical year has come to a close, and the summer has come to an end. Vacations are over, the kids are back to school, and life is becoming a routine again. September is a month that brings with it cooler temperatures, we had two hot and humid months in July and August. It has been a great year filled with anticipation, surprises, and a lot of success.

It was great to see our Sunday school and Greek school programs growing and reaping the fruits of their labor. Great opportunities challenged our young people, and we will continue to give them more opportunities to increase their faith and knowledge within the Church. We are also reminded that parental guidance and commitment is always needed when we deal with the youth of our Parish. Whether it be bringing the kids to Church, Sunday school, Greek school, G.O.Y.A., J.O.Y, and Dance, we expect the Parents to play a major role in their

commitment to their children." We can lead a horse to water but we can't make it drink". As parents you need to set up your priorities. You have to ask yourselves, Is the Church a major priority in the life of your children? With due respect, our children lack in worship, in faith and in knowledge. We are slowly losing our children to the pleasures of this world. We are teaching our children that living a materialistic world is the way to go. still around and play a major role in the progress and success of our Community. I really enjoy when I see our young married couples coming to church on Sunday's with their children. That is the right path to take, because your children will always benefit from that tremendously. September is also the month when our Youth Group gets into action. I want to take this opportunity to thank our Head GOYA Advisor Mrs. Rita Quintero, and her excellent staff of Advisors, plus all of our wonderful and talented coaches, for the support and dedication that they exemplified throughout the year to the GOYANS. I also would like to thank the parents for their sacrifice, their time and effort to bring their children to the meetings, to Church, basketball practices and to all the many activities that they attended last year. I hope and pray that we continue to see growth and excitement in this area, because if we don't support our children and the youth programs we failed to deliver the future for our children. I would like to thank the Hellenic Golden Coins Dancers and

their instructors Foula Paragios, and Irene Angelos, for their participation in all the Dance activities and practices. They performed so beautifully during the Festival. I would like to see more and more of our young children enrolling in our Youth Group and the Hellenic Golden Coins Dance group. That really shows our pride in our children when they represent our Community in all their activities. Also in the month of September we have all the Church Organizations and all Ethnic Societies blooming again. Our Ladies Philoptochos Society, the St. Nicholas "Diamonds", the Ladies Chios Society, the United Ladies Chios Society, the Rhodian Society "Diagoras", the Peloponnesian Society, The Macedonian Society, The Carpathian Society, and AHEPA, will begin their meetings

and events during the 2019 and 2020 year. If I missed any other Organization please forgive me because there are so many.

During the month of September we also have the members of our St. Nicholas Choir back in action. We will be able to hear their beautiful angelic voices glorifying God and making us feel the need to praise and glorify Him spiritually. But before I close with my comments, there are certain important areas that we need to pay our utmost attention. Number 1: The importance of our children attending and participating in Church and other activities. We need our Kids who have graduated from Sunday school, to join our Church Choir, or help with the Sunday School classes as Teachers Aides. Our Choir is getting smaller and smaller as years go by. We need new voices, and new people to get involved. This year we are trying to create a new Youth





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Choir and we hope with help of the parents and young people we can create a new and exciting environment for our children and the future of St. Nicholas. We should be thankful that we have our Greek Town Square Event Center and our Learning Center, are doing very well. We really need to support our Plateia, buy scheduling your events, such as Weddings, Baptisms, Makaria Luncheons, Birthday Parties, Sweet Sixteen Parties, Baby and Wedding Showers, and Graduations. By supporting our Church facilities for your events, you are also supporting your Church financially.

This is what we need to focus on as a Community, because not only does our Plateia and Learning Center provide a great service to our Community, but it can also be a great opportunity to show your "STEWARDSHIP".

According to rules and regulations of the Archdiocese, if you are over 18 years of age and you have a job then you are required to fill out a Stewardship Pledge card to the church. This includes Young Adults, Married Couples, and Elderly. There is just one exemption, and that is if you are enrolled and attending College, all we ask is that you fill out a Pledge Card, so we can communicate with you through our yearly mailings. This will give students the opportunity to know what's happening in their Parish. Number 4: During the months of September, October, and November, we are always looking for new Candidates for the Parish Council. If anyone is interested please contact Fr. Michael. We must all realize the importance of being on the Parish Council of the Church. We will be sending out information concerning the Parish Council Elections that will be held in December in the coming months. We are looking for special people who are willing to devote their time and talents to their Church. In the past we have had the pleasure of putting Young professionals on the Parish Council and we were very happy that they came on board and showed their love and dedication to their church. So on this note, I am inviting and challenging all our Young people who have an interest in their Church to run in this year's Parish Council Elections.

Again, I would like to welcome back everyone to a new and exciting Ecclesiastical Year and may our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ bless all of you and bring you abundant joy and energy for this new and exciting and challenging year.

λλη μια εκκλησιαστική χρονιά έφτασε στο τέλο της, όπως τέλειωσε και το καλοκαίρι. Οι διακοπές τέλειωσαν, τα παιδιά επέστρεψαν στο σχολείο και η ζωή πήρε και πάλι τη ρουτίνα της. Ο Σεπτέμβριος είναι ένας μήνας που φέρνει μαζί του πιο ήπιες θερμοκρασίες, είχαμε 2 μήνες με ζέστη και υγρασία, τον Ιούλιο και τον Αύγουστο. Είχαμε όμως και έναν υπέροχο χρόνο, γεμάτο προσδοκίες, εκπλήξεις και μεγάλες επιτυχίες.

Ήταν υπέροχο να βλέπουμε να διδάσκονται τα προγράμματα του Κατηχητικού και του Ελληνικού μας σχολείου και στη συνέχεια να δρέπουν τους καρπούς της εργασίας τους. Μεγάλες ευκαιρίες πρόκλησης δόθηκαν στους νέους μας και θα συνεχίσουμε να τους προσφέρουμε περισσότερες ευκαιρίες για να αυξήσουμε την πίστη και τη γνώση τους όσον αφορά την Εκκλησία. Υπενθυμίζεται επίσης ότι η καθοδήγηση και η δέσμευση των γονέων είναι πάντα απαραίτητες όταν ασχολούμαστε με τη νεολαία της Ενορίας μας. Είτε πρόκειται να φέρουν τα παιδιά στην Εκκλησία, στο Κατηχητηικό Σχολείο, στο Ελληνικό Σχολείο, στη GOYA, στο JOY η στο Χορευτικό Όμιλο. Περιμένουμε από τους γονείς να παίξουν σημαντικό ρόλο στη δέσμευσή τους για τα παιδιά τους: "Μπορούμε να οδηγήσουμε το άλογο στο νερό, αλλά δεν μπορούμε να το πιέσουμε να πιεί». Ως γονείς πρέπει να ορίσετε τις προτεραιότητές σας. Θα πρέπει να αναρωτηθείτε, κατέχει η Εκκλησία βασική προτεραιότητα στη ζωή των παιδιών σας; Με όλο το σεβασμό, τα παιδιά μας στερούνται λατρείας, πίστης και γνώσης. Σιγά-σιγά χάνουμε τα παιδιά μας εξ αιτίας των απολαύσεων αυτού του κόσμου. Εμείς είμαστε εκείνοι που διδάσκουμε στα παιδιά μας ότι ο τρόπος ζωής είναι ο υλιστικός τρόπος που ζούμε, και πρέπει να τον ακολουθήσουν. Αυτός δεν είναι ούτε ο τρόπος ούτε ο δρόμος που πρέπει να πάρετε αν θέλετε να ζήσετε μια πνευματική ζωή εν Χριστώ. Ο Θεός δεν είναι κάποια ιδέα ή κάποια πληροφορία. Ο Θεός είναι κάποιος που γνωρίζει και που συστήνεται στα παιδιά μας. Πολλές φορές ακούω από τον κόσμο: Ότι είναι λάθος των γονέων αν τα παιδιά δεν παρευρίσκονται στην εκκλησία. Υπάρχει κάποια αλήθεια γι 'αυτό, αλλά θα ήθελα να προσθέσω ότι πρέπει οι γονείς πρώτα να γνωρίσουν τον Θεό, και μετά να ενσταλάξουν και να δείξουν στα παιδιά τους ότι αγαπούν τον Κύριο. Τα παιδιά διδάσκονται από το παράδειγμα. Για παράδειγμα, πολλά

από τα παιδιά που έρχονται στην εκκλησία την Κυριακή τα φέρνουν οι γονείς τους, αλλά οι γονείς τους δεν είναι στην εκκλησία για να εκκλησιαστούν μαζί τους. Συνήθως είναι κάποιος παππούς ή γιαγιά που εκλησιάζεται με τα παιδιά. Κατά κάποιο τρόπο είναι πολύ ωραίο ότι τα παιδιά έρχονται στην εκκλησία, αλλά θα ήταν πολύ καλύτερα, για τα παιδιά, να εκκλησιάζονται μαζί με τους γονείς τους. Ξέρω ότι πολλοί νέοι ενήλικες που μεγάλωσαν στον Άγιο Νικόλαο είχαν την ευκαιρία να έρχωνται στην εκκλησία με τους γονείς τους, επειδή η Εκκλησία βρισκόταν σε κοντινή απόσταση. Η Εκκλησία ήταν η ζωή τους! Αλλά τώρα τα πράγματα έχουν αλλάξει, οι νέες οικογένειες έχουν εγκαταλείψει την ελληνική πόλη και ζουν έξω από την πόλη του Highlandtown, σε άλλες πόλεις. Όμως είμαι ευγνώμων που τα νεαρά παντρεμένα ζευγάρια μας βρίσκονται ακόμα κοντά μας και παίζουν σημαντικό ρόλο στην πρόοδο και την επιτυχία της Κοινότητας μας. Μου αρέσει πραγματικά όταν βλέπω τα νεαρά παντρεμένα ζευγάρια να έρχονται στην εκκλησία την Κυριακή με τα παιδιά τους. Αυτός είναι ο σωστός δρόμος που πρέπει να ακολουθήσετε, διότι τα παιδιά σας θα επωφελούνται πάντα από αυτό. Ο Σεπτέμβριος είναι επίσης ο μήνας κατά τον οποίο η νεολαία μας θα δραστηριοποιηθεί. Θέλω να επωφεληθώ αυτής της ευκαιρίας για να ευχαριστήσω την επικεφαλής σύμβουλο της Νεολαίας μας Ρίτα Κουϊντέρο και το εξαίρετο προσωπικό των βοηθών της, για την υποστήριξη και την αφοσίωση που έδειξαν παραδειγματικά καθ όλη τη διάρκεια του έτους στους νέους μας. Θα ήθελα επίσης να ευχαριστήσω τους γονείς για τη θυσία, τον χρόνο και την προσπάθειά τους που έφερναν τα παιδιά τους στις συνεδριάσεις, στην Εκκλησία, στις πρόβες του Μάσκετ και σε όλες τις πολλές και διάφορες δραστηριότητες που παρακολούθησαν πέρυσι. Ελπίζω και προσεύχομαι να συνεχίσουμε να βλέπουμε την ανάπτυξη και τον ενθουσιασμό σε αυτόν τον τομέα, διότι αν δεν υποστηρίξουμε τα παιδιά μας και τα προγράμματα της νεολαίας δεν πετύχαμε το μέλλον τους. Θα ήθελα να ευχαριστήσω τους χορευτές των Ελληνικών Χρυσών Φλουριών και τους εκπαιδευτές τους, Φούλα Παραγιού και Ειρήνη Αγγελή, για τη συμμετοχή τους σε όλες τις παραστάσεις και πρόβες του Χορού. Επίσης, τον Σεπτέμβριο, ξεκινούν τα προγράμματά τους όλες οι εκκλησιαστικές οργανώσεις και όλοι οι τοπικοί Εθνικοί Σύλλογοι. Η Φιλόπτωχος, τα «Διαμάντια» του Αγίου Νικολάου, Ο Γυναικείος Σύλλογος Χιωτών,

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τα Ηνωμένα Χιακά Σωματεία, ο Ροδιακός Σύλλογος «Διαγόρας», ο Πελοποννησιακός Σύλλογος, ο Μακεδονικός Σύλλογος, ο Σύλλογος Καρπάθου, η ΑΧΕΠΑ, θα ξεκινήσουν τις συνεδριάσεις τους και τις εκδηλώσεις τους του 2019 και 2020. Εάν ξέχασα οποιαδήποτε άλλη οργάνωση παρακαλώ συγχωρήστε με γιατί υπάρχουν τόσες πολλές.

Τον Σεπτέμβριο θα ξαναγυρίσουν επίσης τα μέλη της Εκκλησιαστικής Χορωδίας του Αγίου Νικολάου. Θα μπορέσουμε να ακούσουμε τις όμορφες αγγελικές τους φωνές να δοξάζουν τον Θεό και να μας προκαλούν, να αισθανόμαστε την ανάγκη να Τον δοξάζουμε και κυρίως να Τον δοξάζουμε πνευματικά. Αλλά πριν τελειώσω με τα σχόλιά μου, είναι ορισμένοι σημαντικοί τομείς που πρέπει να δώσουμε τη μέγιστη προσοχή μας. Νο 1: Τη σημασία να παρακολουθούν και να συμμετέχουν τα παιδιά μας σε Εκκλησιαστικές και άλλες δραστηριότητες. Χρειαζόμαστε τα παιδιά, που έχουν αποφοιτήσει από το Κατηχητικό Σχολείο, να συμμετάσχουν στην Εκκλησιαστική μας Χορωδία ή να βοηθήσουν στις τάξεις του Κατηχητικού Σχολείου ως βοηθοί του διδακτικού προσωπικού. Η Χορωδία μας μικραίνει και πάει όσο περνούν τα χρόνια. Χρειαζόμαστε νέες φωνές και νέους ανθρώπους να συμμετέχουν. Φέτος προσπαθούμε να δημιουργήσουμε μια νέα Χορωδία Νέων, και ελπίζουμε, με τη βοήθεια των γονέων και των νέων, να δημιουργήσουμε ένα νέο και ενθουσιώδες περιβάλλον για τα παιδιά μας και το μέλλον του Αγίου Νικολάου. Όλα αυτά μπορούν να υλοποιηθούν, αν το θελήσουμε όλοι μαζί, ενωμένοι, με την καρδιά μας. Νο 2: Πρέπει να δώσουμε μεγαλύτερη προσοχή στο Πρόγραμμα της Εθελοντικής Προσφοράς της Εκκλησίας μας. Σε αυτό το τομέα υστερούμε πολύ. Όλοι πρέπει να γνωρίζουν ότι το πρόγραμμα αυτό είναι η καρδιά και ο πάλμός της Ενορίας μας. Μην περιμένετε από φεστιβάλ, συναυλίες, χορούς, και δείπνα, να καλύψουν τις οικονομικές ανάγκες και ευθύνες της Εκκλησίας, διότι όπως το βλέπω, κάθε χρόνο, έχουμε πάντα πρόβλημα να βρούμε ανθρώπους να βοηθήσουν με αυτές τις εκδηλώσεις. Εἰμαστε πολύ απασχολημένοι με άλλα πράγματα εκτός από του να δίνουμε προσοχή στα θέματα της Εκκλησίας που θάπρεπε να είναι η κύρια προτεραιότητα μας μετά από τα παιδιά και τις οικογένειές μας. Πρέπει η Εκκλησία μας να έχει τη προτεραιότητα στη ζωή μας. Φανταστείτε εάν δεν είχαμε την Εκκλησία, να προσκυνήσουμε ή να ερχόμασταν σε κάποιο κοινωνικό μυστήριο ή γεγονός, και να μαθαίναμε ότι ακυρώθηκε επειδή η Εκκλησία είναι κλειστή. Σε αυτή την περίπτωση που πάμε να εκκλησιαστούμε; Απλά να το έχετε κατά νου, όταν θα συμπληρώσετε την Κάρτα της Εθελοντικής σας Προσφοράς προς την Εκκλησία. Είναι σημαντικό να στηρίζουμε την Εκκλησία μας. Νο. 3. Είναι επίσης σημαντικό να στηρίζουμε τις υπέροχες εγκαταστάσεις που προσφέρει η Εκκλησία μας. Πρέπει να είμαστε ευγνώμονες που έχουμε το Κέντρο Εκδηλώσεων της Πλατείας και το Παιδικό Σταθμό, λειτουργούν πολύ καλά. Πρέπει πραγματικά να υποστηρίζουμε τη Πλατεία μας, προγραμματίζοντας τις εκδηλώσεις μας εκεί, όπως Γάμους, Βαπτίσεις, Γεύματα Μακαρίας, Γιορτές Γενεθλίων, Πάρτι Sweet Sixteen, Showers, Βρεφικά και Γάμου, και εκδηλώσεις αποφοίτησης. Υποστηρίζοντας τις εκκλησιαστικές μας εγκαταστάσεις για τις εκδηλώσεις μας, υποστηρίζουμε οικονομικά την εκκλησία μας. Στο θέμα αυτό πρέπει να επικεντρωθούμε ως Κοινότητα, διότι όχι μόνο η Πλατεία και ο Παιδικός Σταθμός παρέχουν μεγάλη υπηρεσία στην Κοινότητά μας, αλλά επίσης αποτελούν μια μεγάλη ευκαιρία για να δείξουμε την Εθελοντική μας Προσφορά.

Σύμφωνα με τους Κανονισμούς της Ιεράς Αρχιεπισκοπής μας, αν είστε άνω των 18 ετών και δουλεύετε, τότε θα πρέπει να συμπληρώσετε την Κάρτα της Εθελοντικής σας Προσφοράς προς την Εκκλησία. Αυτό περιλαμβάνει νεαρούς ενήλικες, παντρεμένα ζευγάρια και ηλικιωμένους. Υπάρχει μόνο μία εξαίρεση, και αυτή είναι αν έχετε εγγραφεί και φοιτάτε σε Πανεπιστήμιο ή Κολλέγιο, το μόνο που ζητάμε από εσάς είναι να συμπληρώσετε μια κάρτα, ώστε να μπορούμε να επικοινωνούμε μαζί σας μέσω της ετήσιας αλληλλογραφίας μας. Έτσι δίνουμε σε κάθε φοιτητή τη δυνατότητα να γνωρίζει τι συμβαίνει στην Ενορία τους. Νο 4: Κατά τους μήνες Σεπτέμβριο, Οκτώβριο και Νοέμβριο, ζητάμε να βρούμε πάντα νέους υποψήφιους για το Διοικητικό Συμβούλιο. Αν κάποιος ενδιαφέρεται παρακαλώ να επικοινωνήσει με τον Πατέρα Μιχαήλ. Πρέπει όλοι να συνειδητοποιήσετε πόσο σημαντικό είναι να συμμετέχετε στο Διοικητικό Συμβούλιο της Εκκλησίας. Θα σας ταχυδρομήσουμε τις πληροφορίες σχετικά με τις Κοινοτικές εκλογές του Διοικητικού Συμβουλίου που θα πραγματοποιηθούν το Δεκέμβριο, εντός των επομένων μηνών. Ψάχνουμε για άτομα που να είναι πρόθυμα και ικανά να αφιερώσουν το χρόνο και το ταλέντο τους στην Εκκλησία τους. Στο παρελθόν είχαμε τη χαρά να βάλουν υπηψηφιότητα νέοι, επαγγελματίες για το Κοινοτικό Συμβούλιο και ήμασταν πολύ χαρούμενοι που ήρθαν και έδειξαν την αγάπη και την αφοσίωσή τους στην Εκκλησία τους. Έτσι, με αυτό το μήνυμα, καλώ και προκαλώ όλους τους νέους μας που ενδιαφέρονται για την Εκκλησία τους να βάλουν υποψηφιότητα για τις φετεινές Εκλογές του Κοινοτικού Συμβουλίου. Και πάλι, θα ήθελα να σας καλωσορίσω όλους στο νέο Εκκλησιαστικό Έτος και να σας ευχηθώ ο Κύριος και Σωτήρας μας Ιησούς Χριστός να σας ευλογεί, και να σας χαρίζει υγεία, χαρά και ενέργεια, τούτη τη νέα εκκλησιαστική χρονιά.

My Beloved in the Lord,

Today we, much like the disciples Christ took with Him up to Mt. Tabor, follow our Lord and witness Him arrayed in light, transfigured before our eyes. This light shone so brightly the Apostles could not bear it as they beheld the revealed Christ before them, both God and man. The feast of the Transfiguration is a feast that bolsters our faith much as the disciples were fortified in theirs through the events that took place on Mt. Tabor. They were given added courage since Christ knew, as the vesperal hymns of the feast teach us, that His sufferings and crucifixion would test His disciples. We should also acknowledge, however, that the Transfiguration is an event that not only bolstered the faith of the disciples, but it aids in strengthening our faith as well.

But the Gospel reading also points to another important element. When Christ was being transfigured, a voice from the cloud said, "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him" (Matt. 17:5). The disciples were told to listen to Christ and though they were tested through the various events that would come to take place, all of them, except Judas, would come to listen to their Lord. The words of God the Father were not meant just for the disciples, but they hold true for us as well. We must listen to our Lord who constantly shows us the way of righteousness and truth.

We live in a world full of darkness and we must stay focused on our spiritual life even while society constantly bombards us with depraved thoughts and images. Nevertheless, we are given these words by God to remind us to stay focused on Christ despite all the distractions of the world, despite all the fears we may have, and despite the fact that the evil one is working to keep us away from our Lord. We must listen for our Lord's voice, He who guides us as the Good Shepherd, not just in one particular moment, but every day and at every hour. The voice of Christ, the Good Shepherd, asks us to recognize His image in the face of our neighbors and, in doing so, feed the hungry, care for the sick, visit the marginalized, and protect the defenseless. In this way, we listen to our Lord and reinforce our faith while offering a witness of our faith to others.

My beloved in the Lord, the feast of the Transfiguration offers us an opportunity to renew our commitment to Christ by responding to the call of God who tells us to listen to His Son. It is my sincerest prayer that all of us heed this call so that we may live out our faith and offer a witness to a world in need of hope.

NATIVITY OF THE THEOTOKOS - Saturday, September 8TH

Nativity of the Theotokos

Introduction

The Feast of the Nativity of Our Most Holy Lady, the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary is celebrated on September 8 each year. The Feast commemorates the birth of the Mother of Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Biblical Story

The birth and early life of the Virgin Mary is not recorded in the Gospels or other books of the New Testament, however this information can be found in a work dating from the second century known as the Book of James or Protevangelion.

According to the story found in this book, Mary's parents, Joachim and Anna, were childless for many years. They remained faithful to God, but their prayers for a child were unanswered. One day, when Joachim came to the temple to make an offering, he was turned away by the High Priest

who chastised him for his lack of children. To hide his shame, Joachim retreated to the hill country to live among the shepherds and their flocks.

As Joachim was praying, his wife Anna was praying at the same time at their house in Jerusalem. An angel appeared to both of them and announced that Anna would have a child whose name would be known throughout the world. Anna promised to offer her child as a gift to the Lord. Joachim returned home, and in due time Anna bore a daughter, Mary.

Icon of the Feast

The icon of the Nativity of the Thetokos presents to us the central figures of Saints Joachim and Anna, Mary's parents, and the Mother of our Lord as an infant. Saint Anna is in the middle of the icon with her right hand extended toward her daughter. Likewise, Saint Joachim, Mary's father, is gazing upon the young child with his right hand extended toward her. Anna is surrounded by attendants who have assisted with the birth.

The icon directs attention to Mary as the central figure in this feast. It also acknowledges the joy that was felt by Joachim and Anna as new parents with a child received through a promise from God. The liturgical texts of the feast acknowledge this joy and confirm the special role of Mary as the Mother of the Incarnate God, Jesus Christ. In this event, another step is made in sacred history in preparation for the entrance of Christ into the world.

The icon and the feast also acknowledge a transition from barrenness to life. This was but another foreshadowing of what would be offered through Christ, the transformation from death to eternal life.

Orthodox Christian Celebration of the Feast of the Nativity of the Theotokos

The Feast of the Nativity of the Theotokos is celebrated with the Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom which is conducted on the morning of the Feast and preceded by a Matins (Orthros) service. A Great Vespers is conducted on the evening before the day of the Feast. Scripture readings for the Feast are the following: At Vespers: Genesis 28:10-17; Ezekiel 43:27—44:4; Proverbs 9:1-11. At the Matins: Luke 1:39-49, 56. At the Divine Liturgy: Philippians 2:5-11; Luke 10:38-42; 11:27-28.

45th Anniversary Cyprus Invasion Remembrance 2019

My Beloved in the Lord,

As we reflect on the events of the Turkish Invasion of Cyprus forty-five years ago, we are once again reminded of the severe injustices perpetrated by the ruling powers of Turkey against our Cypriot brothers and sisters who endured immense hardships in the midst of a world that turned a blind eye to Turkey's cruelty.

Families were torn apart, neighbors were pinned against one another, churches were destroyed, hundreds of thousands of people were forced out of their homes under the guise and false pretense of a peacekeeping mission, and thousands died as they tried to protect themselves against the unjust hands of tyranny. Turkey had once again engaged in "ethnic cleansing" by forcibly removing one-third of the ethnically Greek-Cypriot population and illegally dividing a nation. These grave injustices are just a few in a litany of others which have been committed by Turkey. Sadly, these injustices have not been rectified and, lamentably, even more injustices have followed.

Such hostile actions have become all too common in that region as Turkey has since engaged in further acts of violence and oppression, not only against Cyprus, but against Greece and even her own citizens as well. Turkey has engaged in heinous activities since it was known as the Ottoman Empire. Its desire to exterminate the Orthodox faith, Hellenic history, Hellenic culture, and the Greek language has shown no bounds and has continued even to the modern era in ways that are less visibly obvious, but equally as destructive. The enslavement of the Greek people during the Ottoman occupation, the genocides committed in the 20th century, the forced closing of the Halki Theological School, and the continued oppression of Turkey against our Mother Church, the Ecumenical Patriarchate, are just some examples of Turkey's persistence to annihilate our faith, our culture, and our people.

But in the face of these continued tragedies, we must continue to stand strong against the forces of evil, against oppression, and against injustice. We must never fail to be a voice for our Orthodox faith, religious freedom, political freedom, and righteousness. As Greek Orthodox Christians we must reflect on these events not with hopelessness in our hearts, but with a determination in our souls to ensure that righteousness will prevail. Let us not speak of these events as a part of history past, but let us continue to actively advocate for the victims of these atrocities, realizing that this chapter of history may have started decades ago, but it is far from being completed.

Finally, I ask as we remember this solemn anniversary of our fallen mothers and fathers, sisters and brothers, friends and neighbors, that we pray for the repose of their souls and for their entrance into God's Eternal Kingdom. May we continually reflect on the events of July 1974, prayerfully remembering those who lost their lives in the struggle for liberty and their struggle for justice in Cyprus. Τιμοῦμε σήμερα τήν Ἐπέτειο τῆς Τουρκικῆς εἰσβολῆς στήν Κύπρο πρίν ἀπό 45 χρόνια, καί θυμόμαστε τήν φοβερή ἀδικία πού διαπράχθηκε ἀπό τήν κυβερνητική ἐξουσία τῆς Τουρκίας ἐναντίον τῶν Κυπρίων ἀδελφῶν μας, οί ὁποῖοι πέρασαν διαμέσου πολλῶν δοκιμασιῶν, ἐνῶ τήν ἴδια ἄρα ἡ κοινή γνώμη διεθνῶς σιωποῦσε καί παρέβλεπε τήν τουρκική ἀγριότητα.

Οἰκογένειες χωρίσθηκαν, γείτονες στράφηκαν ἐναντίον τοῦ ἑνός πρός τόν ἄλλον, Ιεροί Ναοί κατεστράφηκαν, ἑκατοντάδες χιλιάδων ἀνθρώπων ἐξορίσθηκαν ἀπό τίς πατρογονικές τους ἑστίες μέ τό πρόσχημα τῆς προσπάθειας σταθεροποίησης τῆς εἰρήνης στήν περιοχή, καί χιλιάδες ἄλλοι πέθαναν προσπαθῶντας νά προστατευθοῦν ἀπό τά ἄδικα χέρια τῶν τυρράνων. Ἡ Τουρκία τότε, προέβη σέ «ἐθνική ἐκκαθάριση», ξεριζώνοντας μέ τήν βία τό ἕνα τρίτο τοῦ Ἑλληνο-Κυπριακοῦ πληθυσμοῦ ἀπό τά σπίτια τους, διχάζοντας παράνομα ἕνα όλόκληρο ἔθνος. Αὐτή ἡ φοβερή ἀδικία ἀποτελεῖ μόνο μία ἀπό μιά σειρά ἄλλων ἀδικιῶν πού διαπράχθηκαν ἀπό τήν Τουρκία. Δυστυχῶς, αὐτές οἱ ἀδικίες δέν ἔχουν μέχρι σήμερα διορθωθεῖ καί μάλιστα ἔχουν ἀκολουθήσει καί πολλές ἄλλες.

Τέτοιες ἐχθοικές ποάξεις καί ἐνέογειες εἶναι πλέον συνηθισμένες στήν πεοιοχή, καθώς ή Τουρκία ἔχει προχωρήσει καί σέ ἄλλες βίαιες καί καταπιεστικές ἐνέργειες ὅχι μόνον ἐναντίον τῆς Κύπρου, ἀλλά καί τῆς Ἑλλάδος καί ἀκόμη καί ἐναντίον τῶν ἴδιων τῶν κατοίκων της. Ἱστορικῶς, ἡ Τουρκία προβαίνει σέ ἀποτρόπαιες ἐνέργειες ἀπό τή ἐποχή τῆς Όθωμανικῆς Αὐτοκρατορίας. Ἡ ἐπιθυμία της νά ἐξαφανίσει τήν Ὀρθόδοξη πίστη, τήν Ἑλληνική Ἱστορία, τόν Ἑλληνικό Πολιτισμό, καί τήν Ἑλληνική Γλῶσσα δέν ἔχει ὅρια καί συνεχίζει καί στήν σύγχρονη περίοδο καί ἱστορία, μέ μεθόδους ὅμως πού δέν φαίνονται ξεκάθαρα ὅπως τότε, ἀλλά πού εἶναι ὅμως τό ἴδιο καταστρεπτικές. Ἡ ὑποδούλωση τῶν Ἑλλήνων κατά τήν Ὀθωμανική κατάκτηση, οί γενοκτονίες πού διαπράχθησαν κατά τόν 20°

αἰῶνα, τό βίαιο καί ἄδικο κλείσιμο τῆς Θεολογικῆς Σχολῆς τῆς Χάλκης, καί ἡ συνεχιζόμενη καταπίεση πρός τήν Μητέρα Ἐκκλησία, τό Οἰκουμενικό Πατριαρχεῖο, ἀποτελοῦν μερικά μόνο ἀπό τά πολλά παραδείγματα τῆς Τουρκικῆς ἐπιμονῆς ὥστε νά ἐκμηδενίσει τήν πίστη μας, τόν πολιτισμό μας, τόν λαό μας.

Καθώς ὅμως ἐρχόμαστε ἀντιμέτωποι μέ τήν συνεχιζομένεη αὐτή τραγωδία, ὀφείλουμε νά παραμένουμε δυνατοί καί σταθεροί ἐναντίον τῶν πονηρῶν αὐτῶν δυνάμεων, ἐναντίον τῆς καταπίεσης, ἐναντίον τῆς ἀδικίας. Ὀφείλουμε πάντοτε νά γινόμαστε ἡ δυνατή φωνή ὑπεράσπισης τῆς Ὀρθοδόξου πίστης μας, τῆς θρησκευτικῆς ἐλευθερίας, τῆς πολιτικῆς ἐλευθερίας, καί τῆς νομιμότητας. Ὠς Ὀρθόδοξοι Χριστιανοί ὀφείλουμε νά θυμόμαστε αὐτά τά ἱστορικά γεγονότα, ὅχι ὅμως ἔχοντας ἀπαισιοδοξία στίς καρδιές μας, ἀλλά μέ ἀποφασιστικότητα ὅτι στό τέλος θά ἐπικρατήσει ἡ νομιμότητα. THE ELEVATION OF THE CROSS - Saturday, September 14th

The Elevation of the Venerable and Life-Giving Cross

Introduction

Saint Helen, the mother of Saint Constantine the Great, when she was already advanced in years, undertook, in her great piety, the hardships of a journey to Jerusalem in search of the cross, about the vear 325. A temple Aphrodite been raised up by the Emperor Hadrian upon Golgotha, to defile and cover with oblivion the place where the saving Passion had been suffered. The venerable Helen had the statue of Aphrodite destroyed, and the earth removed, revealing the Tomb of our Lord, and three crosses. Of these, it was believed that one must be that of our Lord, the other two of the thieves crucified with Him; but Saint Helen was at

a loss which one might be the Wood of our salvation. At the inspiration of Saint Macarius, Archbishop of Jerusalem, a lady of Jerusalem, who was already at the point of death from a certain disease, was brought to touch the crosses, and as soon as she came near to the Cross of our Lord, she was made perfectly whole. Consequently, the precious Cross was lifted on high by Archbishop Macarius of Jerusalem; as he stood on the ambo, and when the people beheld it, they cried out, "Lord have mercy." It should be noted that after its discovery, a portion of the venerable Cross was taken to Constantinople as a blessing. The rest was left in Jerusalem in the magnificent church built by



Saint Helen, until the year 614. At that time, the Persians plundered Palestine and took the Cross to their own country (see Jan. 22, Saint Anastasius the Persian). Late, in the 628, Emperor vear Heraclius set out on a military campaign, retrieved the Cross, and after bringing it Constantinople, himself escorted it back to Jerusalem, where he restored it to its place.



A DELEGATION FROM THE STANDING CONFERENCE OF ORIENTAL ORTHODOX CHURCHES (SCOOCH) VISITS ARCHBISHOP ELPIDOPHOROS



NEW YORK – His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros met today, Monday, August 12, 2019, with a delegation from the Standing Conference of Oriental Orthodox Churches (SCOOCH), which was comprised of His Grace Bishop David (Coptic - President of SCOOCH), His Eminence Mor Dionysios (Syriac), His Eminence Mor Titus (Malankara), His Eminence Archbishop Silvanos (Malankara-Syriac Knanaya) and His Grace Bishop Daniel (Armenian).

Recent changes in both SCOOCH and the Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops of the USA, a strong desire for unity, and the need to reinvigorate the joint dialogue – especially on matters of pastoral concern – were openly discussed. The group proceeded to agree on a joint Christmas concert, for which details are forthcoming.

Reflecting on the meeting, Archbishop Elpidophoros commented, "we cannot let what happened in the past prevent us from living in the present and looking to the future. For that reason, I am excited to continue working with our Oriental brothers and sisters toward not only common understanding but full unity of faith and communion."

All Orthodox Christians are urged to honor Saint Luke of Simferopol by hymns and ask for his intercession to the Lord.

Our Lord, God and Savior Jesus Christ

Dearest brother Hierarchs and beloved children in the Lord,

With the goodness and grace of the all-bountiful God, today marks the 30th anniversary since the Holy Great Church of Christ established the feast of Indiction and first day of the ecclesiastical year as "the day of environmental protection." We did not only address our Orthodox faithful, nor again just Christian believer or even representatives of other religions, but also political leaders, environmentalists and other scientists, as well as intellectuals and all people of good will, seeking their contribution.

The ecological activities of the Ecumenical Patriarchate served as the inspiration for theology to advance prominently the truth of Christian anthropology and cosmology, the Eucharistic worldview and treatment of creation, along with the spirit of Orthodox asceticism as the basis for understanding the reason for and response to the ecological crisis. The bibliography related to theological ecology or ecological theology is extensive and on the whole constitutes an admirable Orthodox witness before the major challenges of contemporary humanity and earthly life. Concern for the ecological crisis and for the global dimensions and consequences of sin – of this alienating internal "reversal of values" in humankind – brought to the surface the connection between ecological and social issues as well as for the need to address them jointly. Mobilizing forces for the protection of the integrity of creation and for social justice are interconnected and inseparable actions.

The interest of the Ecumenical Patriarchate for the protection of creation did not arise as a reaction to or as a result of the contemporary ecological crisis. The latter was simply the motivation and occasion for the Church to express, develop, proclaim and promote its environmentally-friendly principles. The foundation of the Church's undiminished concern for the natural environment lies in its ecclesiological identity and theology. Respect and care for creation are a dimension of our faith, the content of our life in the Church and as the Church. The very life of the Church is "an experienced ecology," an applied respect and care for creation, and the source of its environmental activities. In essence, the interest of the Church for the protection of the environment is the extension of the Holy Eucharist in all dimensions of its relationship to the world. The liturgical life of the Church, the ascetic ethos, pastoral service and experience of the cross and resurrection by the faithful, the unquenchable desire for eternity: all of these comprise a communion of persons for which the natural reality cannot be reduced to an object or useful matter to meet the needs of an individual or humanity; by contrast, this reality is considered as an act, deed the handiwork of a personal God, who calls us to respect and protect it, thereby rendering us His "coworkers," "stewards," "guardians," and "priests" of creation in order to cultivate a Eucharistic relationship with it.

Care for the natural environment is not an added activity, but an essential expression of church life. It does not have a secular, but rather a purely ecclesiastical character. It is a "liturgical ministry." All of the initiatives and activities of the Church are "applied ecclesiology." In this sense, theological ecology does not merely refer to the development of an ecological awareness or the response to ecological problems on the basis of the principles of Christian anthropology and cosmology. On the contrary, it involves the renewal of the whole creation in Christ, just as this is realized and experienced in the Holy Eucharist, which is an image and foretaste of the eschatological fullness of the Divine Economy in the doxological wholeness and luminous splendor of the heavenly kingdom.

Most honorable brothers and most precious children in the Lord,

The ecological crisis reveals that our world comprises an integral whole, that our problems are global and shared. In order to meet these challenges, we require a multilayered mobilization, a common accord, direction and action. It is inconceivable for humankind to recognize the severity of the problem and yet continue to behave in oblivion. While in recent decades the dominant model of economic development in the context of globalization – highlighting the fetishism of financial markers and magnification of financial profit – has exacerbated ecological and economic problems, the notion still prevails widely that "there is no other alternative" and that not conforming to the rigid validity logic of the world's economy will lead to unbridled social and financial situations. Thus, any alternative forms of development, along with the power of social solidarity and justice, are overlooked and undermined.

For our part, however, we are obliged to assume greater measures for the application of the ecological and social consequences of our faith. It is extremely vital that our archdioceses and metropolises, as well as many of our parishes and sacred monasteries, have fostered initiatives and activities for the protection of the environment, but also various programs of ecological education. We should pay special attention to the Christian formation of our youth, so that it may function as an area of cultivation and development of an ecological ethos and solidarity. Childhood and adolescence are particularly susceptible life phases for ecological and social responsiveness. Aware of the urgency of environmental education, the Ecumenical Patriarchate devoted the Third in its series of international Halki Summits to the subject of "Theological Education and Ecological Awareness" (Istanbul, May 31st to June 4th, 2019) with a view to incorporating ecology and environmental awareness into programs and curricula of theological schools and seminaries. The solution to the great challenges of our world is unattainable without spiritual orientation.

In conclusion, then, we wish all of you a favorable and blessed ecclesiastical year, filled with works pleasing to God. We invite the radiant children of the Mother Church throughout the world to pray for the integrity of creation, to be sustainable and charitable in every aspect of their lives, to strive for the protection of the natural environment, as well as the promotion of peace and justice. And we proclaim once more the truth that there can be no genuine progress, when the "very good" creation and the human person made in the image and likeness of God suffer. Finally, through the intercession of the first-among-the-saints Theotokos Pammakaristos, we invoke upon you the life-giving grace and boundless mercy of the Creator and Provider of all.

HIS ALL-HOLINESS ECUMENICAL PATRIARCH BARTHOLOMEW Statement on the Global Wildfires

In recent weeks, our planet has witnessed extreme heatwaves and expansive wildfires throughout the world—from the rain forests of the Amazon and desert regions of Africa, normally snow-covered regions such as the Arctic and Alaska to far away countries from Spain to Siberia. Month after month, we have experienced record temperatures and unprecedented heatwaves, resulting in the destruction of millions of acres and the disruption of millions of people. And the intensity of these fires and storms is progressively increasing and intensifying, mandating critical and commensurate changes on our part.

Scientists warn us about the threat of such fires to the world's ecosystems, which are becoming increasingly jeopardized and vulnerable. The impact of these fires could reverberate for generations, affecting soil, infrastructure, and human beings. Trees are vital for the soil, for our survival and for our soul. Trees are not simply valuable for their aesthetic beauty or commercial benefit, but essentially for our defense against climate change. Planting more trees is certainly commendable, but cutting down less trees is perhaps the most compelling response to global warming.

While this global wildfire crisis may not entirely or exclusively be a consequence or cause of climate change, the calamitous events that the world is now experiencing undoubtedly and undeniably sound the alarm about the urgent and dire repercussions of a rising level of carbon emissions. Therefore, if nothing else, such extreme phenomena compel us to consider the fundamental fragility of nature, the limited resources of our planet, and the unique sacredness of creation.

In our Encyclical that will appear on September 1st, we outline the diverse initiatives and activities pioneered by the Ecumenical Patriarchate over the last thirty years, while observing the fundamental principles and precepts proposed by the Orthodox Church over the last twenty centuries with regard to preserving God's creation.

We pray for all those threatened or afflicted by the fires in all corners of our world. We call all faithful and all people of good will to consider carefully how we live, what we consume, and where our priorities lie, using the words of the Divine Liturgy: "Let us pay attention! Let us stand with awe!"

Esteemed Members of the Metropolitan Council, Esteemed Members of the Parish Councils, Philoptochos Sisterhood, Faculty and Students of the Catechetical and Greek Afternoon Schools, Directors and Participants of all Youth Organizations, and all devout Orthodox Christians of the Communities of the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of New Jersey

My Beloved in the Lord,

Once again our nation has endured too much heartache, too much anguish, and far too much loss when we experienced not just one, but two mass shootings this past week, specifically in El Paso, Texas and in Dayton, Ohio. At least twenty-nine have lost their lives and dozens more wounded due to the vicious and senseless acts of two persons filled with anger and hate since it appears that in at least one of these events, race was the impetus for the attack. Such malice towards one other human being is inconceivable enough, but to target this many people is simply evil.

Some may ask themselves, "Why does God allow this to happen?" Why does He allow even one person to die this way, much less twenty-nine? The answer may lay in the fact that God listens to our prayers and He hears our supplications, but He also provides us with the ability to use our freedom to combat these evils. These shooters were not born like this. They did not grow up in childhood wanting to do this. They were not created with hatred in their hearts and a proclivity to kill. God made humanity inherently good since we are all made in His image and likeness. It is because of the fall and because we as a society continuously fail to address these pressing issues that these tragedies continue.

God has given us the intelligence, the rationality, and the aptitude for confronting these issues using our own freedom. The question then becomes, what are we doing to confront these problems? Hundreds of thousands of Americans, family and friends, co-workers and neighbors, suffer with untreated psychological issues. The plague of racism and hatred against fellow human beings is a continuous blight on our society that we have not yet fully addressed. Balancing personal freedoms with common-sense solutions contributes to our inability to protect our communities. All of these and several other issues are at the root of this problem.

Above all, the main issue is that many have forgotten how to see the person of Christ in their neighbor. If we were able to come to this simple yet profound realization, there would be no evil in the world. It is something we must work at achieving and it is something that cannot be kept only to ourselves, but shared with all people.

My beloved in the Lord, these tragedies have tried our spirits, but we must not lose heart that, with the Lord's help and in allowing Him to guide us to address these underlying issues, we may overcome the pain these heartbreaking events. The psalmist tells us, "Weeping may endure for the night, but joy comes in the morning" (Ps. 30:5). Though our nation has suffered much in these past few days we can be confident, if we place our trust in God and put our faith into action, that love, tolerance, and peace will prevail. I pray you all endeavor to live Christ-like lives and to spread the joy of the Gospel so that we may combat evil by using love as our weapon of peace.
