Message from Fr. Michael L. Pastrikos

REFLECTIONS ON THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST

Every time this issue of the Resurrection comes up there is always in some people's minds an issue that is never answered and that issue is "Did Christ Truly Rise from the Dead." In this article, I will try to answer this question to the best of my ability. In Acts 1:3, we read from the Apostle Paul, which he wrote to the Corinthian church stressing in detail, the "many infallible proofs that Christ is risen indeed". St. Paul says: "But if there be no Resurrection of the dead, then is not Christ risen and if Christ has not risen, then is our preaching

vain, and your faith is also vain." (I Corinthians 15: 13-14).

During that time, there were many who doubted whether the dead would ever live again. Probably there are doubters today that feel the same way. Will this world ever change? I hope so! Let's look at the bright side of this issue. Try telling the people who were affected directly with Christ that His Resurrection from the cross was a myth. Try telling that to the Apostles who were with Him throughout His ministry. Try telling that to His mother, "The Virgin Mary", who gave birth to Him. Try telling that to "Lazarus" and those who witnessed his coming out from the tomb after being dead for four days. Try telling that to the son of the widow of Nain, the daughter of Jarius that their children were not returned to them alive. Try telling that to the women who woke up early that morning and came to the tomb and witnessed an open tomb. As soon as they saw the empty tomb, they were amazed and they were greeted by an angel exclaiming to them, "Fear not, for I know that you seek Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here, for He is risen, as He said".



(Matthew 28: 5-6)

If we take for a moment and glance at the New Testament writings, we will find plenty of proof that Christ did truly rise from the grave and that truly there is life after death. Christ made all these miracles a reality so those who were healed and those who witnessed these events would believe even more when it came to His Resurrection.

So, let's reflect back to the theme of this article, which is: "After His Crucifixion did Christ truly rise from the dead?". I say this; we have people today in our

congregations and in other Christian faiths that play the doubting Thomas game. They want to believe, but in their hearts and minds, they cannot make that decision because at the moment they are not positive in their faith. Because for them, they have to see it before they believe it. If you really desire to witness and learn more about the Passions, the truth of the Gospels, the teachings of Christ and to reflect on the Crucifixion, the Resurrection and the Ascension of our Lord, all you have to do is follow a week full of knowledge, excitement and reflection. For Orthodox Christians. we call this week "Holy Week". It is the most important and significant week of the entire church year. During this week, the church reenacts the entire passion of Christ. It brings the past into the present. It relives the event so that we today may experience for ourselves. In many ways, it's like a TV program, which was called "Your are There", that made us relive the present with actual historical events.

If we take the Jewish faith, they celebrate the Exodus from Egypt, they re-live every year the

Στοχασμοί/Σκέψεις για την Ανάσταση Του Χοιστού

Κάθε φορά που αναφέρουμε το θέμα της Ανάστασης, πάντα υπάρχει μια μερίδα ανθρώπων που αμφιβάλλει αν ΠΡΑΓΜΑΤΙΚΑ ΑΝΑΣΤΗΘΗΚΕ Ο ΧΡΙΣΤΟΣ ΝΕΚΡΩΝ. Θα προσπαθήσω να σας εξηγήσω και να απαντήσω σ' αυτή την ερώτηση όσο πιο καλά μπορώ. Στις Πράξεις: 1:3 διαβάζουμε στην επιστολή του Απόστολου Παύλου προς την εχκλησία της Κορινθίας, που αναλύει με λεπτομέρειες τις τόσες αλάθητες αποδείξεις ότι ο Χριστός πράγματι ανεστήθη. Ο Απόστολος Παύλος λέγει: « Αλλά αν δεν έγινε η Ανάσταση εκ νεκρών, τότε ο Χριστός δεν ανεστήθη και αν δεν ανεστήθη, τότε το κήρυγμά μας είναι μάταιο, όπως μάταιη είναι και η πίστη σας.» (Προς Κορινθίους 15:13-14).

Τον καιρό εκείνο, υπήρχαν άνθρωποι που αμφέβαλαν αν οι νεκροί θα αναστηθούν. Ίσως να υπάρχουν ακόμη και σήμερα άνθρωποι που αμφιβάλουν και αισθάνονται παρομοίως. Θα αλλάξει ποτέ αυτός ο κόσμος? Το ελπίζω! Ας δούμε την καλή πλευρά αυτού του θέματος, και ας προσπαθήσουμε να αναφερθούμε στους ανθρώπους που πιστεύουν ότι η Ανάσταση Του μετά την Σταύρωση, ήταν μύθος. Δοχιμάστε να το πείτε αυτό στους Αποστόλους που ήταν συνεχώς μαζί Του, σε όλες Του τις ιερατικές περιοδείες. Προσπαθείστε να το πείτε στην μητέρα Του «Την Παρθένο Μαρία, που Τον γέννησε. Προσπαθείστε να το πείτε στο Λάζαρο, και σε εκείνους που ήταν παρόντες

όταν βγήκε από τον τάφο του, τέσσερεις ημέρες μετά τον θάνατό του. Πέστε το στον υιό της χήρας από την Ναΐν, την θυγατέρα του Ζαΐρου ότι τα παιδιά τους δεν γύρισαν ζωντανά. Πέστε το στις γυναίχες που ξύπνησαν νωρίς το πρωΐ και ήλθαν στο τάφο Του και είδαν με τα ίδια τους τα μάτια τον τάφο ανοιχτό. Αμέσως μόλις είδαν τον τάφο ανοικτό εξεπλάγησαν και άγγελοι τις υποδέχθηκαν εξηγώντας τους «Μην φοβάστε, γνωρίζουμε ότι ψάχνετε τον Ιησού, που εσταυρώθη, δεν είναι εδώ: Ανεστήθη! $(M\alpha\tau\theta...28:5-6-).$

Αν ρίξουμε μια ματιά στη Καινή Διαθήκη θα διαπιστώσουμε ότι υπάρχουν πολλές αποδείξεις ότι ο Χριστός πράγματι αναστήθηκε από τον τάφο και ότι πράγματι υπάρχει ζωή μετά θάνατο. Ο Χριστός έχανε τόσα θαύματα στην πραγματηκότητα, ούτως ώστε όσοι θεραπεύτηκαν και όσοι έγιναν μάρτυρες αυτών, να πιστέψουν ακόμη περισσότερο, την Ανάστασής Του.

Ας επανέλθουμε λοιπόν στο θέμα αυτού του άρθρου που είναι «Μετά την Σταύρωσή Του ανεστήθη πραγματικά ο Χριστός εκ νεκρών» Σας λέω μόνο τούτο, υπάρχουν σήμερα άνθρωποι στην ενορία μας αλλά και σε άλλα Χριστιανικά δόγματα, που παίζουν το παιχνίδι του άπιστου Θωμά. Θέλουν να πιστέψουν, αλλά δεν μπορούν βαθιά μέσα τους

The Sunday Scripture Lessons of Great Lent, Part II

In Part I of our examination of the Sunday Scripture lessons of Great Lent, we noted that while most of the Lenten Sundays have acquired secondary themes, the primary spiritual message the Church intends to convey on these days is found in their Epistle and Gospel readings. These lessons focus on God the Father's plan of redemption for mankind accomplished through the Incarnation, Passion, Death and Resurrection of His Beloved Son, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. They also emphasize the appropriate response of truly faithful Christians to God's offer of salvation.

The instructional nature of these readings, we explained, can be traced to the fact that originally Lent was an extended period of preparation for new Christians, the Catechumens, who would be baptized at the Paschal liturgy. The teaching dimension of these texts is especially evident in the Epistles, which are all from Hebrews. Appropriately, Hebrews details the meaning of Old Testament worship that foreshadowed Christ's High Priestly office and the significance and redemptive power of His sacrifice on the Cross.

The readings for the first two Sundays of Lent, we noted, disclose to us God's promise to redeem mankind and the anticipatory hope and struggles of those Old Testament saints who patiently awaited the fulfillment of that promise. They also highlight the determined faith and courage required of those of us blessed to have seen and obtain in the coming of our Lord the realization of that promise.

On the 3rd Sunday of Lent, the Veneration of the Cross, the Scripture selections, we discovered, introduce the meaning of Christ's suffering and sacrifice on the Cross and our personal identification with His suffering and sacrifice. We learn in the day's Epistle that Christ is our merciful High Priest who gave Himself as a propitiation for our sins. The Gospel that follows exhorts us to take up our own Crosses through self-denial, suffering and rejection of sin for the sake of Christ and His Kingdom.

Turning now to the last two Sundays of Lent, we find that the Cross and Its significance continue to be the emphasis of the Church's instruction in the Epistle and Gospel selections. The 4th Sunday's Epistle (Heb. 6:13-20) tells us that Jesus, "having become High Priest forever" has entered the Heavenly sanctuary for us "behind the veil" into the very presence of God to offer sacrifice for our sins. This hope, "both steadfast and sure" is explained as the fulfillment of God's promise that through Abraham's progeny all nations would be blessed (Gen. 22:18). In the Gospel that follows (Mark9:17-31) Jesus, after explaining to his disciples the necessity of prayer and fasting for the spiritual life reveals to them that He will be betrayed and killed and that "after He is killed, He will rise on the third day". With this prophecy of His Passion, the Church begins its journey with the Lord towards Calvary and His ultimate victory over sin and death.

The Scripture readings for the last Sunday of Lent confirm and complete the concepts set forth in those of the previous Sunday. The Epistle (Heb.9:11-14) reveals that what Christ, our High Priest, offered at the heavenly altar was His own precious Blood given "one for all" in order to obtain "our eternal redemption". We are told that through the "eternal spirit" Christ offered Himself "without spot to God". The final Sunday Gospel of Lent (Mark10:32-45) begins with another of our Lord's prophecies about His Death and Resurrection and ends with His exhorting His disciples and us to loving selfless service to others of which He is the greatest example for "the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as ransom for many".

With this call for the faithful to imitate and identify with Christ's supreme Self-sacrifice, the Lenten Sunday Scriptures conclude having prepared us to complete our passage to witness, proclaim and rejoice in our Lord's glorious Resurrection.

The Epistle and Gospel of the following Sunday, Palm Sunday, express the Church's joyful expectation as it awaits Pascha. The Epistle (Phil.4:4-9) reminds us that "the Lord is at hand" and because of this we should be "anxious for nothing". The Gospel (John12:1-18) captures the essence of our anticipatory elation and hope: "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord."

Διατηρώντας Ζωντανό το Πνεύμα Αγάπης

Έχουν περάσει αρκετοί μήνες από τότε που εορτάσαμε τη χαρμόσυνη γέννηση του Κυρίου μας. Καθώς βρισκόμαστε στη μέση της Μεγάλης Τεσσαρακοστής, ας αναρωτηθούμε: Το πνεύμα αγάπης των Χριστουγέννων υπάρχει ακόμη μέσα μας, διατηρείται ακόμη ζωντανό? Φροντίζουμε ιδιαίτερα τους γείτονές μας, δείχνουμε ενδιαφέρον για τα προβλήματά τους? Αφιερώνουμε λίγα λεπτά από το χρόνο μας να τους τηλεφωνήσουμε, να τους στείλουμε ένα μήνυμα, ή να περιποιηθούμε κάποιους από τους γεροντότερους, τους μοναχικούς, αυτούς που νοσηλεύονται σε νοσοκομεία, ή τους κατάκοιτους? Αυτό δεν είναι το μήνυμα που μας έδωσε ο Θεός, όταν έστειλε τον αγαπημένο Του Υιό να μας κηρύξει τη διδασκαλία Του της πραγματικής αγάπης με απτά παραδείγματα? Η προσωπική μας συμμετοχή σαν Χριστιανοί είναι να εκτελούμε τις εντολές Του.

Καθώς προετοιμαζόμαστε τώρα για την Αγία Του Ανάσταση, θα πρέπει να ενδυμναμώνεται η αγάπη μας, και το κέντρο της σκέψης μας να συγκεντρώνεται στη φροντίδα του πλησίον μας, που διατηρεί το πνεύμα των Χριστουγέννων ζωντανό. Όλοι μαζί μπορούμε να κάνουμε μεγάλο καλό στο δυστυχή συνάνθρωπό μας, ειδικότερα σήμερα που περνάμε μια οικονομική κρίση. Εκτός από δωρεές φαγητού και ρουχισμού, μπορούμε προσωπικά και εθελοντικά να δώσουμε το χρόνο μας και να εξυπηρετήσουμε αυτούς που μας χρειάζονται. Είναι άριστα παραδείγματα προς μίμηση για τη νεολαία μας, και τους παρακαλούμε να συμμετέχουν σ'αυτές τις δραστηριότητες. Η πληρωμή τους θα είναι η εκτίμηση όλων αυτών που δέχθηκαν τη βοήθειά τους. Δεν μας είπε ο Κύριος ότι όταν ταΐζουμε τον πεινασμένο και ντύνουμε τον

φακένδυτο, στην πραγματικότητα ταΐζουμε και ντύνουμε Εκείνον?

Το φιλανθοωπικό αίσθημα όλων εμφανίζεται κυρίως κατά τη διάρκεια των εορτών των Χριστουγέννων, αλλά πολλές εκκλησίες και ιδρύματα οργανώνουν φιλανθρωπικές εκδηλώσεις κατά τη διάρκεια μεγάλων θρησκευτικών εορτών ή μεγάλων εορτών, όπου πολλοί άνθρωποι συμμετέχουν για να βοηθήσουν τους φτωχούς συμπολίτες τους. Πολλοί επιλέγουν την εποχή που δεν υπάρχει κάτι σημαντικό διότι ποτέ δεν πρέπει να ξαχνάμε αυτούς που έχουν την ανάγκη μας. Για καλή τύχη υπάρχουν πολλοί Χριστιανικοί Οργανισμοί οι οποίοι διαθέτουν πνευματικό και χρηματικό υλικό για την εκπλήρωση των αγαθοεργιών και της αποστολής τους καθ' όλο το χρόνο.

Η Φιλόπτωχος της Ενορίας μας, όπως και όλης της Αμερικής, είναι μια φιλανθρωπική οργάνωση αυτού του είδους. Γι' αυτό το λόγο πρέπει να συμμετέχουμε προσωπικά και να υποστηρίζουμε οικονομικά τις διάφορες εκδηλώσεις του Αγίου Νικολάου. Με το τρόπο αυτό η εκκλησία μας με τους διάφορους Οργανισμούς της, όπως είναι και η Φιλόπτωχος, έχει την ικανότητα να επιτελεί το έργο της, το έργο που ο Χριστός μας έχει αναθέσει: να αγαπάμε και να φοοντίζουμε τον πλησίον μας.

Η παρουσία μας και συμμετοχή μας στις διάφορες Ακολουθίες κατά τη διάρκεια της Σαρακοστής και της Μεγάλης Εβδομάδας σκοπό έχει να διατηρήσει το επίκεντρο του στόχου μας που είναι και η σημασία της Χριστιανοσύνης. Έτσι διατηρείται το Πνεύμα Αγάπης των Χριστουγέννων ζωντανό και πέραν από την 25η Δεκεμβρίου.

PROPER CHURCH ETIQUETTE

There are various parts of the Liturgy during which no one should be moving about. Wherever a person happens to be at these moments, he or she should stop and stand reverently, until the proper time to proceed to the pew. These parts of the Liturgy are:

- 1. During the Procession of the Priest and the Altar Boys with the Holy Gospel.
 - 2. During the reading of the EPISTLE and the Gospel.
 - 3. During the SERMON.
- 4. During the CHERUBIC HYMN and the Procession of the Priest and the Altar Boys with the Holy Gifts.
- 5. During the recitation of the CREED (in which the whole Congregation should participate).
- 6. During the SE YMNOUMEN and the prayers of the Consecration of the Holy Gifts.
- 7. During the LORD'S PRAYER in which the whole Congregation should participate.
 - 8. During HOLY COMMUNION.
 - 9. During the Dismissal Prayers.
- 10. During any special Services (Memorial Services, Processions, Special Prayers, etc.)

One basic rule to follow is that, whenever the Priest is outside of the Altar either with the Censer or giving the Blessing, everyone should stand wherever they are.

According to actual Church Service procedures, each and every member of the Congregation is required to be seated in the pews at the beginning of the Service. It is only by leniency that anyone is allowed to enter the Church once the Services have begun. Thus, we ask that you do not take undue advantage of this leniency. Also Liturgy Books are available in the pews to follow the service.

Please remember that the Parish Council members are required to maintain order during Church Services. Thank you for following their direction.
