Μήνυμα από τον Πατέρα Μιχαήλ Λ. Παστορικό

Το καλοκαίρι τέλειωσε και μπήκαμε για τα καλά στο Φθινόπωρο. Οι ημέρες μικραίνουν και οι νύχτες μεγαλώνουν. Θα έχουμε πιο πολύ σκοτάδι και λιγότερο φως. Αλλά, γνωρίζουμε καλά, κι εγώ και εσείς, ότι ο Χριστός είναι το Φως του κόσμου, και έτσι δεν φοβόμαστε το σκοτάδι.

Κάποιος τοπικός Ορθόδοξος Ιερέας είπε στο κύριγμά του: Κατά τους πρώτους αιώνες της Χριστιανοσύνης, την εποχή των διωγμών, οι πιστοί προσεύχονταν στις κατακόμβες, κρυμμένοι στα υγρά υπόγεια. Οι πιστοί χριστιανοί έχονταν σ' αυτές τις κατακόμβες να προσφέρουν δεήσεις παρόλο το σκότος, την υγρασία, και την παγωνιά, μακριά από τους διώκτες τους. Αν λοιπόν θα θέλαμε να μοιραστούμε και να απολαύσουμε τούτο το Φως πρέπει να προσέξουμε περισσότερο την πνευματική μας ζωή.

Σήμερα στις εκκλησίες μας, έχουμε τη δυνατότητα να προσευχόμαστε και να ασκούμε την θρησκεία μας ελεύθερα. Μπορούμε να ψάλλουμε με άνεση τους εκκλησιαστικούς ύμνους, να συζητούμε ελεύθερα τα θέματα της πίστης μας, και να συμμετέχουμε ελεύθερα στα Άγια Μυστήρια της Εκκλησίας. Βέβαια φροντίζουμε ιδιαίτερα την ανθρωπινή ζωή μας, αλλά σαν κοινωνία εγκαταλείπουμε την πνευματική μας ζωή.

Τι μπορεί να μας προσφέρει αυτός ο κενός και αμαρτωλός κόσμος; Δεν υπάρχει τίποτα ωραιότερο ή τελειότερο από το Θεό. Ο Λόγος της αλήθειας βρίσκεται στην Εκκλησία. Στον έξω κόσμο του Θεού βρίσκουμε μόνο κενό, διχόνοια, μίσος και αστάθεια. Στο κόσμο της χριστιανοσύνης βρίσκουμε στοργή, αλήθεια, αγάπη και χαρά—που είναι αισθήματα πραγματικά και πάντοτε σταθερά. Μέσω της Εκκλησίας και του Χριστού, βρίσκουμε την αληθινή όση των ψυχών μας.

Πάντοτε φωτάμε: Πως θα βρούμε τον Χριστό; Πως μπορούμε να αλλάξουμε τον τρόπο ζωής μας και να πλησιάσουμε περισσότερο το Θεό; Η απάντηση είναι πολύ απλή. Πρέπει να προσευχόμαστε περισσότερο, και να νηστεύουμε ακόμη πιο πολύ. Μια ημέρα άκουσα κάποιον να λέει «δεν πιστεύω στην ηστεία, και ούτε πιστεύω ότι πρέπει να προσευχόμαστε για να είμαστε καλοί χριστιανοί». Τότε δεν πιστεύετε στα όσα μας δίδαξε ο Κύριος ημών Ιησούς Χριστός. Στη

σημερινή κοινωνία μας αρέσει να διαλέγουμε και να επιλέγουμε τι μας αρέσει και τι δεν μας αρέσει από την διδασκαλία του Χριστού. Υπάρχει μια ωσπή στους σημερινούς ανθρώπους να διαμορφώνουν το Χριστό σύμφωνα με το τι νομίζουν εκείνοι ότι θάπερε πεντε να είναι. Ο Χριστός θάναι πάντοτε ο ίδιος, χθες, σήμερα και αύριο. Δεν μπορούμε να Τον αλλάξουμε σύμφωνα με τα δικά μας μέτρα και ιδέες.

Ένα άλλο σημαντικό συστατικό που θα μπορούσαμε να χρησιμοποιήσουμε ως αυτοπροστασία είναι η αξία της σοφίας. Που θα βρούμε όμως αυτή την σοφία? Με την ανάγνωση της Αγίας Γραφής. Η Αγία Γραφή είναι γεμάτη με τη σοφία του Θεού. Η Εκκλησία είναι γεμάτη με τη σοφία του Θεού. Όταν ο κόσμος, ή ακόμη και τα δικά μας μέλη, πάνε κάπου αλλού να ψάξουν να βρουν κάτι πιο αξιόλογο και ουσιαστικό, συνήθως γίνεται για δύο λόγους. Είτε έχουμε αποτύχει σαν εκκλησία, ή οι άνθρωποι έχουν αποτύχει στη ζωή τους εδώ, και θέλουν να πιστεύουν κάτι άλλο.

Σήμερα, διαβάζουμε τις εφημερίδες και τα περιοδικά περισσότερο από ότι διαβάζουμε την Αγία Γραφή ή τους βίους των Αγίων ή άλλα θρησκευτικά συγγράμματα. Αν κοιτάξετε στα ράφια της βιβλιοθήκης του σπιτιού σας, πόσα θρησκευτικά βιβλία θα βρείτε? Αν τα θρησκευτικά βιβλία είναι περισσότερα από τα άλλα, τότε βαδίζετε στο σωστό δρόμο. Αν όχι, τότε πραγματικά χάνετε τον αγώνα. Εμείς ως Χριστιανοί, πρέπει να συγκεντρώσουμε τη προσοχή μας περισσότερο στις ανάγκες της πνευματικής μας πληρότητας παρά στη φυσική μας καλοπέραση.

Πότε ήταν η τελευταία φορά που κάνατε μια καλή πράξη; Δώσατε τροφή στον πεινασμένο, νερό στο διψασμένο, ρούχα στο ρακένδυτο, επισκεφθήκατε τους κατάκοιτους, και βοηθήσατε στην ενίσχυση των οικονομικών εράνων της εκκλησίας? Αυτές είναι οι πράξεις αγάπης που θέλει ο Θεός να συμμετέχουμε.

Να θυμάστε, όλα τα πράγματα, εκτός από την πίστη μας, μας οδηγύν στο θάνατο και στο κενό. Μόνο η πίστη μας στο Χριστό και την εκκλησία Του, μας οδηγεί στην αιώνια ζωή.

Αντιθέτως, ας πιαστούμε γερά από την πίστη μας, σαν νάταν το μόνο πραγματικό και χειροπιαστό πράγμα που μπορούμε πάντοτε να έχουμε μαζί μας.

Pastoral Message from Fr. Michael L. Pastrikos

Summer is over and we are in the fall season. Days will get shorter and the nights longer. There will be more darkness than light. But you and I know that Christ is the Light of the world and therefore we are not afraid of darkness.

One local Orthodox priest in his sermon said: "In the first centuries of Christianity, in times of persecution, the faithful prayed in the catacombs, hidden in the damp underground. Faithful Christians came to these catacombs to offer prayers despite the darkness, dampness, and frightful cold, away from their persecutors. If we are going to share and to bask in that light, we need to pay more attention to our spiritual lives."

Today in our churches, we have the right to pray and to exercise our religious freedom. We are able to peacefully sing hymns of praise, to discuss openly the issues of our faith and to partake freely of the Holy Sacraments of the Church. We are certainly taking good care of our physical lives and well being, but as a society we are also neglecting our spiritual well being.

What can this empty, sinful world give back to us? There is nothing more beautiful or perfect than God. The Word of Truth is in the church in the world outside of God we find emptiness, as well as dissension, hate, and instability. In the Christian world we find tenderness, truth, love and joy; which is real and stable at all times. Through Christ and the Church, we find the true oasis for our souls.

The question is always asked: "How do we find Christ?" "How can we change the way we live to come closer to God?"

The answer is very easy! We need to pray more and fast more. The other day I heard someone say, I don't believe in fasting, nor do I believe that we must pray in order to be better Christians. That you don't believe in what our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ teaches us? In today's society, we like to

pick and choose what we like or dislike about Christ's teachings. There is a tendency with people today to mold Christ into what we think He should be. Christ will always be the same yesterday, today and tomorrow. We cannot change Him to fit our ideas.

The value of wisdom is another important ingredient that we could use as a weapon to armor ourselves. Where do we find this wisdom? By reading the Holy Bible? The Holy Bible is filled with the wisdom of God. The church is filled with the wisdom of God. When society or even our own members go elsewhere to look for something more meaningful and substantive, it is often due to two things. First, whether we have failed as a church, and second, people's lives are not grounded here and wish to believe something else.

Today, we read the newspapers and magazine much more than we read the Holy Bible or the Lives of the Saints or other religious material. If you look at your bookshelf at home, how many religious books are found there? If there are more religious books on the shelves then we are running in the right direction. If not, than we are truly losing the race. We as Christians must focus more on the needs of our spiritual fulfillment than our physical well-being.

When was the last time we did something charitable? Give food to the hungry, water to the thirsty, clothing to the naked, visit the shut-in and helped at the church's fundraisers? These are the kind acts of Love that God wants us to be a part of.

Remember, all things, other than our faith, lead to death and nothingness. Only faith in Christ, in His church is eternal life. Instead, let us cling to our faith as the only real, tangible thing we can always carry with us.

SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS

Sunday School began its lessons on Sunday, September 21st. We welcome our returning students and look forward once again to teaching and sharing our Orthodox faith. **This year as last year, all students and staff must be in church by 10 am** in order to hear the Epistle and Gospel reading, and of course Fr. Michael's sermon. The students are encouraged to sit with their family while in church. We will remain there until Holy Communion and thereafter go to our classrooms. We want to remind you the parents to please make sure you prepare your children to take Communion on Sundays.

We welcome our returning teachers who volunteer to give their time and talent to teach our young students about their faith. We would also like to welcome our new teachers and aides. Registration will continue in the Sunday school office after church services. The enrollment fee for each child is still \$10. This fee will offset the cost of the books and materials they will receive to help them with their lessons.

Last month, we wrote about a riddle that a teacher had asked his students. "In what way are a flower, a flute and a candle alike?" One boy answered, "They're all made by God." Of course, he was right. But they are also alike in another way. Here is the answer: There is one important lesson we can learn from these three things; they were made to be GIVING THINGS. The flower gives its beauty and its fragrance. The candle gives its light and heat. And the flute gives its beautiful music. If these three things did not give away their gifts, they would be of little worth. The God Who created beauty and light and heat and fragrance and music is a giving God.

If God Who gives Himself away, and Who gave His Precious Son Jesus to save us from sin, created things that give themselves away, for what purpose do you think did He create us? Answer: He created us to be givers. In what ways can we give ourselves to others? We can give ourselves to God, i.e., commitment, obedience. We can give to the needy. We can give kind words to others. We can give our friendship, or give our smile. We can also give our support to our church. To sum it up, as Father Michael mentions in his Pastoral Message, quote "These are the kind acts of Love that God wants us to be apart of."

NEA TOY KATHIKHTIKOU SXOLEIOU

Το Κατηχητικό Σχολείο άρχισε τα μαθήματά του την Κυριακή 21 Σεπτεμβρίου. Καλωσορίζουμε όλα τα παιδιά που επέστρεψαν στις τάξεις τους ανυπομονώντας, για μια ακόμη φορά, να μοιραστούμε και να διδάξουμε την Ορθόδοξη πίστη μας. **Εφέτος, όπως και πέρυσι, παρακαλούνται, όλο το διδακτικό προσωπικό και οι μαθητές, να είναι στην Εκκλησία το αργότερο μέχρι τις 10 π.μ.** για να ακούσουν τον Απόστολο και το Ευαγγέλιο, και φυσικά το κήρυγμα του Πατέρα Μιχαήλ. Παρακαλούνται οι μαθητές να κάθονται με την οικογένειά τους όσο είναι μέσα στην Εκκλησία. Θα παραμένουν στην Εκκλησία μέχρι να λάβουν Θεία Κοινωνία και μετά θα πηγαίνουν στις τάξεις τους. Παρακαλούνται επίσης οι γονείς να προετοιμάζουν τα παιδιά τους κατάλληλα για να λάβουν Θεία Κοινωνία, τις Κυριακές.

Καλωσορίζουμε όλες τις νέες δασκάλες που εθελοντικά προσφέρουν την ώρα τους και την επιτηδειότητά τους στους μαθητές και τη πίστη τους. Επίσης καλωσορίζουμε όλους τους νέους μαθητές και βοηθούς του διδακτικού προσωπικού. Οι εγγραφές θα συνεχιστούν στο Γραφείο του Κατηχητικού Σχολείου, μετά το τέλος της Θείας Λειτουργίας. Η εγγραφή για κάθε μαθητή είναι \$ 10, που καλύπτει τα κόστος των βιβλίων και του εκπαιδευτικού υλικού που χρησιμοποιούμε για να βοηθήσουμε τα παιδιά να μάθουν.

Τον περασμένο μήνα γοάφαμε ένα αίνιγμα, που ένας δάσκαλος ρώτησε τους μαθητές του «ποια σχέση υπάρχει μεταξύ ενός λουλουδιού μιας φλογέρας και ενός κεριού» Ένα

αγόρι απάντησε «όλα τα δημιουργησε ο Θεός». Φυσικά, είχε δίκιο! Άλλα μιαίσουν μεταξύ τους και με άλλους τρόπους. Η σωστή απάντηση είναι ότι αυτά τα τοία πράγματα μιας διδάσκουν ένα σημαντικό μάθημα. Είναι όμως τα τοία δημιουργημένα για να ΠΡΟΣΦΕΡΟΥΝ ΠΡΑΓΜΑΤΑ. Το λουλούδι δίνει τα όμορφα άνθη τους και το άρωμά τους. Το κερό δίνει το φως του και τη ζεστασία του. Και η φλογέρα προσφέρει την γλυκόλαλη μουσική της. Αν τα τοία αυτά πράγματα δεν έδιναν τα δώρα τους, τότε δεν θα άξιζαν τίποτα. Ο Θεός που δημιουργησε την ομορφιά, το φως, τη ζέστη, το άρωμα και τη μουσική είναι ο δημιουργός Θεός.

Αν ο Θεός, ο οποίος προσφέρει τον ίδιο του τον εαυτό, και που προσφέρει τον πολύαγαπημένο Του υιό, τον Ιησού, για να μας σώσει από τις αιματίες, έφτιαξε αυτά τα πράγματα που δίνουν από τον εαυτό τους, τότε με ποιο σκοπό, νομίζετε, ότι δημιουργησε εμάς; Απάντηση: Μας δημιουργήσε για να γίνονται δωρητές. Με ποιόν λοιπόν τρόπο μπορούμε να δίνουμε στους άλλους; Μπορούμε να προσφέρουμε στο Θεό, π.χ. υπόσχεση και υπακοή. Μπορούμε να δίνουμε στους φτωχούς. Μπορούμε να μιλάμε ευγενικά στους άλλους. Μπορούμε να δίνουμε τη φιλία μας, ή το χαμόγελο μας. Όπως επίσης μπορούμε να δίνουμε την υποστήριξή μας στην Εκκλησία μας. Ολοκληρώνοντας, όπως αναφέρει και ο Πατέρας Μιχαήλ στον Μήνυμά του, επί λέξη «Αυτές είναι οι πράξεις που αγαπά ο Θεός και που μας θέλει να συμπιετέχουμε».

A message from John E. Gavrilis, CEO

The Greektown CDC would like to thank all of our community residents for participating in our National Night Out. Over 50 residents met at the corner of Bank and Lehigh Street to celebrate the neighborhood and promote safety. The Greektown CDC plans to create more events that bring all of our neighbors and community stakeholders together to discuss our vision and future. We have recently created a Sanitation Committee that focuses on housing code and sanitation issues of the neighborhood. This committee is comprised of 15 members and continues to grow with each month's meeting. We are very proud of the great attendances and look forward to seeing more participation. We as an organization are only as strong as our supporters and

we thank all of those who continue to do so. We continue to provide a monthly dumpster at the corner of Quail and Foster; October 25, November 22, and December 13, 2008.

As the effort to develop the Pemco property continues, the Greektown CDC has taken the lead on developing a comprehensive plan that will best suit the community. We have partnered with the Southeast CDC, Bayview Community, Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center and other adjacent stakeholders to incorporate everyone's input for a reasonable site plan. The streetscape construction continues to move forward and we will finally see an end to all of the lane closings and traffic congestion we have experienced this past year. The Department of Transportation is scheduled to pave Eastern Avenue mid to late October, which will conclude the Greektown streetscape. The CDC continues to work with the City to advocate for more parking spaces and safety changes that will tie into our next phase of economic development.

The Greektown CDC maintains the public safety effort in our community and is proud to report that Greektown is one of the only communities in Southeast Baltimore that has had a decrease in crime over the past few months, according to the Southeastern Police District. Our effort includes a foot officer, monthly meetings at Southeastern Police District, Bi-Weekly Citizen on Patrol Walks, cooperation with the MTA police and the monitoring of CCTV cameras at the police station. We still need your help in crime deterrence, please remember to call 911 when witnessing any crime or illegal activity as soon as it happens. Our next Community on Patrol walks will be held on October 8th and 22nd at 6pm on the Wachovia parking lot. We look forward to seeing you!


