

Message from Fr. Georgios Oikonomou, Protopresbyter

My beloved brothers and sisters in Christ, members of St. Nicholas Community!

We are already entering, with God's blessing and grace, into February, the second month of the year 2025. Reflecting on the passage of time, we observe that it flows swiftly yet with purpose, guided by the charitable and beneficial will of the Most High God. Time moves at the pace He has ordained, and we are called to use it for the benefit of our souls—to do good, perform virtuous deeds, and refrain from evil. As the Apostle Paul writes in his letter to the Corinthians, we are living in "the acceptable season."

These words inspired the holy hymnographer to compose a beautiful hymn, sung at the Vespers on Forgiveness Sunday:

> *Behold, this is the acceptable season;* behold, this is the season of repentance. Let us put away the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light, so that we may navigate the immense ocean of Lent, and arrive at the third-day Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, the Savior of our souls.

The month of February is truly a blessed time, for it marks the opening of the Triodion. This signals the beginning of our spiritual preparation for Holy Easter. Step by step, from the Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee to Forgiveness Sunday, we ascend the spiritual ladder. With renewed fervor and commitment, we will embrace the fasting of Great Lent on Holy Monday, continuing our journey through spiritual struggle until Holy Week and the celebration of Holy Easter.

On this sacred journey, the words of the hymn above resonate deeply in our hearts, offering guidance and illumination. The hymn calls us to spiritual awakening and vigilance, urging: "Now is the time! Let us not miss this opportunity. Now is the time to offer a welcome sacrifice to God." It is a time to repent, to change our lives, and to return to God, our Father, and His holy house,



the Church. We are called to cast off the soiled garments of sin. Living in darkness, we have soiled the all-bright and pure robe of our souls, which we received at our baptism in the name of the Holy Trinity. Yet now is the time to discard these garments and clothe ourselves with the spiritual armor of light.

In doing so, we become passengers aboard the noetic ship of the Church, captained by Christ Himself, as we sail the sea of fasting. Our destination is the glorious third-day Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, who grants salvation to our souls.

How beautiful and instructive are the hymns of our Church! They are, in essence, the songs of God—divine melodies that lift us from earth to heaven, from the temporal world of corruption to the eternal kingdom. These hymns comfort aching hearts and inspire us to draw closer to our heavenly Father and to love our neighbors.

I lovingly urge you to make attending church a priority in the coming months, so that you may partake in the joy and blessings of worship. Let participation in the sacraments and services hold a central place in your life, ensuring that the time that passes will indeed be an "acceptable season."

ΜΗΝΥΜΑ ΠΡΩΤΟΠΡΕΣΒΥΤΕΡΟΥ ΓΕΩΡΓΙΟΥ ΟΙΚΟΝΟΜΟΥ

Αγαπητοί μου αδελφοί εν Χριστώ, ενορίτες και ενορίτισσες του Αγίου Νικολάου!

Εισερχόμαστε ήδη με την ευλογία και τη Χάρι του Θεού στον Φεβρουάριο, τον δεύτερο μήνα του σωτηρίου έτους 2025. Φιλοσοφώντας το πέρασμα του χρόνου μπορούμε να παρατηρήσουμε ότι ο χρόνος κυλάει γρήγορα μα επίσης κυλάει φιλάνθρωπα και ευεργετικά. Κυλάει με τον ρυθμό, που η αγάπη του Πανάγαθου Θεού προνόησε και εμείς καλούμαστε να τον αξιοποιούμε για την ωφέλεια της ψυχής μας. Για να πράττουμε έργα καλά και αγαθά και όχι πονηρά. Να είναι, όπως γράφει ο Απόστολος Παύλος στους Κορινθίους, «καιρός ευπρόσδεκτος». Αυτά τα λόγια του Αποστόλου Παύλου ενέπνευσαν τον ιερό υμνογράφο, για να συνθέσει έναν θαυμάσιο ύμνο, που ψάλλεται στον κατανυκτικό Εσπερινό την Κυριακή της Τυρινής.

Λέει ο ύμνος εκείνος:

«...ἰδοὺ καιρὸς εὐπρόσδεκτος· ἰδοὺ καιρὸς μετανοίας, ἀποθώμεθα τὰ ἔργα τοῦ σκότους, καὶ ἐνδυσώμεθα τὰ ὅπλα τοῦ φωτός, ὅπως διαπλεύσαντες τὸ τῆς Νηστείας μέγα πέλαγος, εἰς τὴν τριήμερον ἀνάστασιν καταντήσωμεν, τοῦ Κυρίου καὶ Σωτῆρος ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ, τοῦ σώζοντος τὰς ψυχὰς ἡμῶν».

Ο μήνας Φεβρουάριος είναι μήνας ευλογημένος. Γιατί κατά τη διάρκειά του θα «ανοίξει» το Τριώδιο. Θα ξεκινήσει η πνευματική προετοιμασία όλων των πιστών της Αγίας μας Εκκλησίας για το Άγιο Πάσχα. Και θα ανεβούμε ένα ένα τα σκαλοπάτια από την Κυριακή του Τελώνου και του Φαρισαίου μέχρι την Κυριακή της Τυρινής, ενώ στη συνέχεια με εντονότερο πνευματικό αγώνα και άσκηση πρόκειται να υποδεχτούμε την Καθαρά Δευτέρα τη νηστεία της Μεγάλης Σαρακοστής, για να συνεχίσουμε το πνευματικό μας ταξίδι μέχρι τη Μεγάλη Εβδομάδα και το Άγιο Πάσχα.

Σε αυτό το ταξίδι ηχούν στην καρδιά μας τα λόγια του παραπάνω ύμνου, που θα τα ερμηνεύσουμε ελεύθερα, καθοδηγώντας μας και φωτίζοντας τον δρόμο μας. Μας

προτρέπει λοιπόν ο ύμνος σε μία πνευματική αφύπνιση και εγρήγορση και λέει: «τώρα είναι ο κατάλληλος καιρός! Ας μη χάσουμε την ευκαιρία. Τώρα είναι ο καιρός, που αν τον αξιοποιήσουμε με καλό τρόπο θα είναι μια ευπρόσδεκτη θυσία στον Θεό. Είναι καιρός να μετανοήσουμε. Να αλλάξουμε τον τρόπο της ζωής μας. Να επιστρέψουμε κοντά στον Θεό Πατέρα μας και τον άγιο οίκο Του, την Εκκλησία. Να ξεντυθούμε τα λερωμένα ρούχα της αμαρτίας, καθώς ζώντας στο σκοτάδι πράξαμε έργα αντίθετα στον νόμο του Θεού και λερώσαμε τον ολοφώτεινο και ολόλευκο χιτώνα της ψυχής μας, που είχαμε φορέσει τη μέρα που βαφτιστήκαμε στο όνομα της Αγίας Τριάδας. Τώρα όμως είναι ο κατάλληλος καιρός να ξεφορέσουμε τα λερωμένα ρούχα και να ντυθούμε τα πνευματικά όπλα του φωτός. Έτσι θα είμαστε επιβάτες του νοερού καραβιού, της Εκκλησίας, που κυβερνά ο Ίδιος ο Χριστός μας, ώστε να διαπλεύσουμε το πέλαγος της νηστείας. Ενώ λιμάνι και προορισμός είναι η τριήμερη Ανάσταση του Κυρίου και Σωτήρα μας Ιησού Χριστού, που χαρίζει τη σωτηρία στις ψυχές μας.

Πόσο όμορφοι και διδακτικοί είναι οι ύμνοι της εκκλησίας μας! Αληθινά υπέροχοι. Είναι θα μπορούσαμε να πούμε με απλά λόγια τα τραγούδια του Θεού. Τραγούδια που μας ανεβάζουν από τη γη στον ουρανό, από τον κόσμο της φθοράς στην αιωνιότητα. Παρηγορούν τις πονεμένες καρδιές των ανθρώπων και εμπνέουν μια ζωή πιο κοντά στον επουράνιο Πατέρα μας αλλά και πιο κοντά στον πλησίον.

Σας προτρέπω με αγάπη να προγραμματίσετε από τώρα τον εκκλησιασμό σας τους επόμενους μήνες, ώστε να μη στερηθείτε τη χαρά και την ευλογία της λατρείας της εκκλησίας. Ας είναι πρώτη προτεραιότητα στη ζωή μας η συμμετοχή στα ιερά μυστήρια και τις ακολουθίες, ώστε ο χρόνος που κυλάει να είναι όντως «καιρός ευπρόσδεκτος».



PRESENTATION OF OUR LORD - FEBRUARY 2

The Presentation of Our Lord and Savior in the Temple

Reading

When the most pure Mother and Ever-Virgin Mary's forty days of purification had been fulfilled, she took her first-born Son to Jerusalem on this, the fortieth day after His birth, that she might present Him in the temple according to the Law of Moses, which teaches that every first-born male child be dedicated to God, and also that she might offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtle-doves or two young pigeons, as required by the Law (Luke 2:22-24; Exod. 13:2; Lev. 12:6-8). On this same day, a just

and devout man, the greatly aged Symeon, was also present in the temple, being guided by the Holy Spirit. For a long time, this man had been awaiting the salvation of God, and he had been First Tone informed divine by revelation that he would not die until he beheld the Lord's Christ. Thus, when he beheld Him at that time and took Him up into his aged arms, he gave glory to God, "Now lettest singing: Thou Thy servant depart in peace, O Master. . ."

And he confessed that he would close his eyes joyfully, since he had seen the Light of revelation for the nations and the Glory of Israel (Luke 2:25-32). From ancient times, the Holy Church has retained this tradition of the churching of the mother and new-born child on the fortieth day and of the reading of prayers of purification.

The Apodosis of the Feast of the Meeting in the Temple is usually on the 9th of February. This, however, may vary if the Feast falls within the period of the Triodion. Should this occur, the Typicon should be consulted for specific information concerning the Apodosis of the Feast.




